

Student Placement and Class Management Policy

In accordance with the Education and Children's Services Act 2019 (SA) and the Child Safety (Prohibited Persons) Act 2016 (SA), Rockit Performing Arts (RPA) establishes the following policy regarding class placement and management:

Class Placement

RPA reserves the right to determine class placement for all students based on the following criteria:

1. Age
2. Ability
3. Dance experience

This determination is made to ensure the safety, well-being, and optimal learning environment for all students, in line with the Children and Young People (Safety) Act 2017 (SA).

Prerequisites and Instructor Permission

Certain classes may require prerequisites or explicit permission from the instructor. These requirements are implemented to maintain the quality of instruction and ensure student safety, as per the Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA).

Class Cancellation

RPA reserves the right to cancel any class with insufficient registration. This decision is made in the interest of resource management and to maintain the viability of our programs, in accordance with the Fair Trading Act 1987 (SA).

Faculty Changes

All faculty members are subject to change. In the event of such a change, RPA commits to substituting with an equally qualified instructor. This ensures continuity of education and maintains compliance with the Education and Children's Services Act 2019 (SA) and the Child Safety (Prohibited Persons) Act 2016 (SA).

RPA will implement this policy in a fair and transparent manner, in line with South Australian anti-discrimination laws and the Equal Opportunity Act 1984 (SA).
